We are trying something new! Homework will mostly consist of work that your student did not complete during the school day. Rarely will there be formally assigned Math/ELA homework this year. We do, however, expect every student to read for 20 minutes and to practice math facts for 5 minutes each night. Along with this, there will be a written response to their reading later in the year. We will send a note when we implement that writing response.

Research has yet to prove that homework improves student performance. So, instead we ask that you spend your evenings doing things that directly correlate with student success such as talking to your child about their school day/friendships, eating dinner as a family, playing outside and getting exercise, reading together, and helping to ensure a restful sleep.
